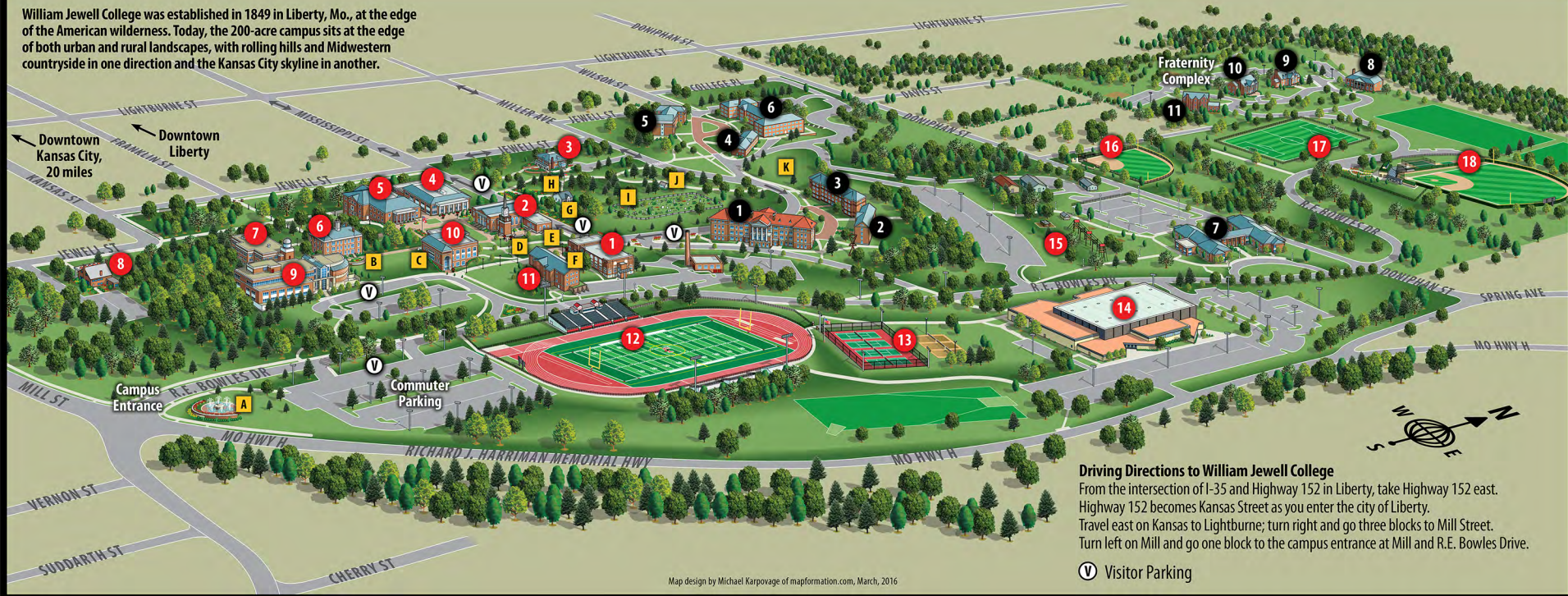


# CAMPUS MAP

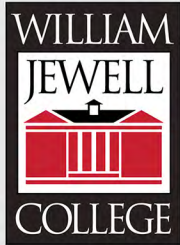
William Jewell College was established in 1849 in Liberty, Mo., at the edge of the American wilderness. Today, the 200-acre campus sits at the edge of both urban and rural landscapes, with rolling hills and Midwestern countryside in one direction and the Kansas City skyline in another.



**Driving Directions to William Jewell College**  
 From the intersection of I-35 and Highway 152 in Liberty, take Highway 152 east. Highway 152 becomes Kansas Street as you enter the city of Liberty. Travel east on Kansas to Lightburne; turn right and go three blocks to Mill Street. Turn left on Mill and go one block to the campus entrance at Mill and R.E. Bowles Drive.
